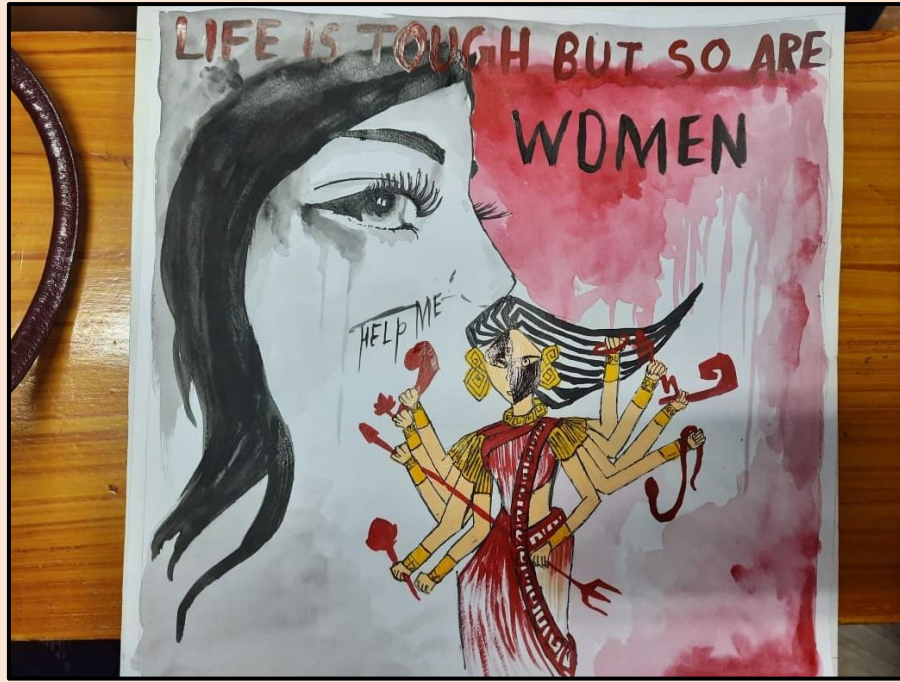

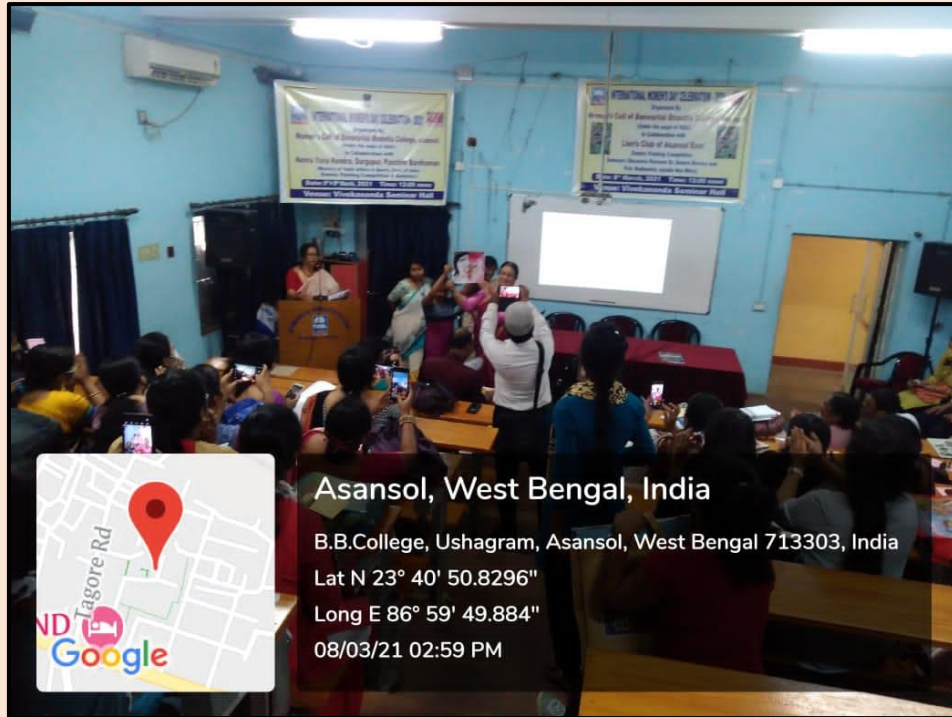

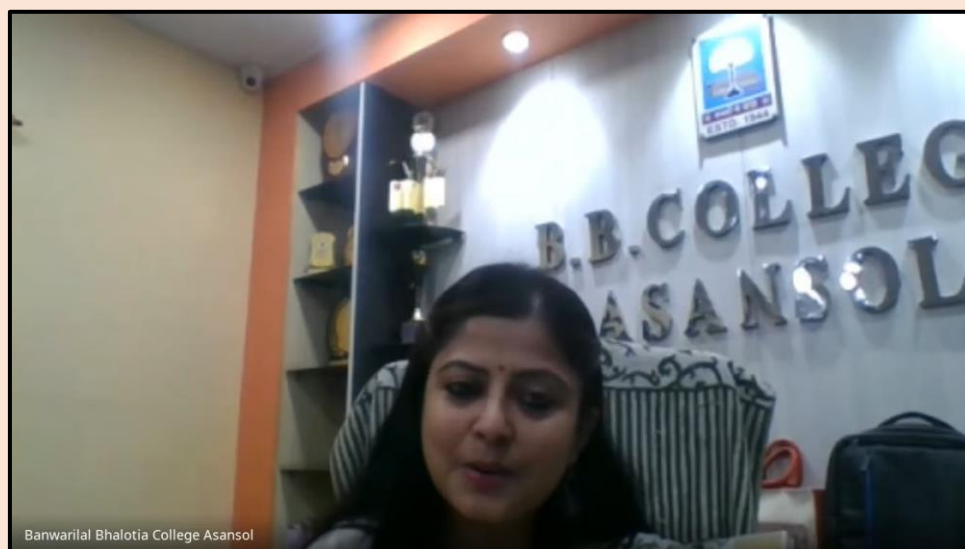

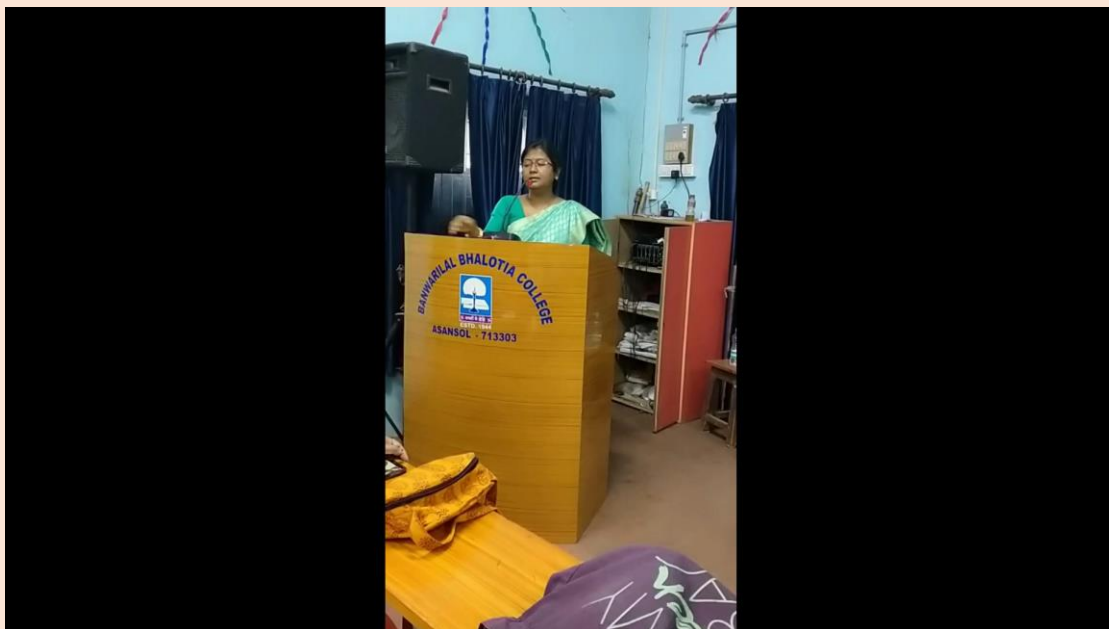
Feedback:

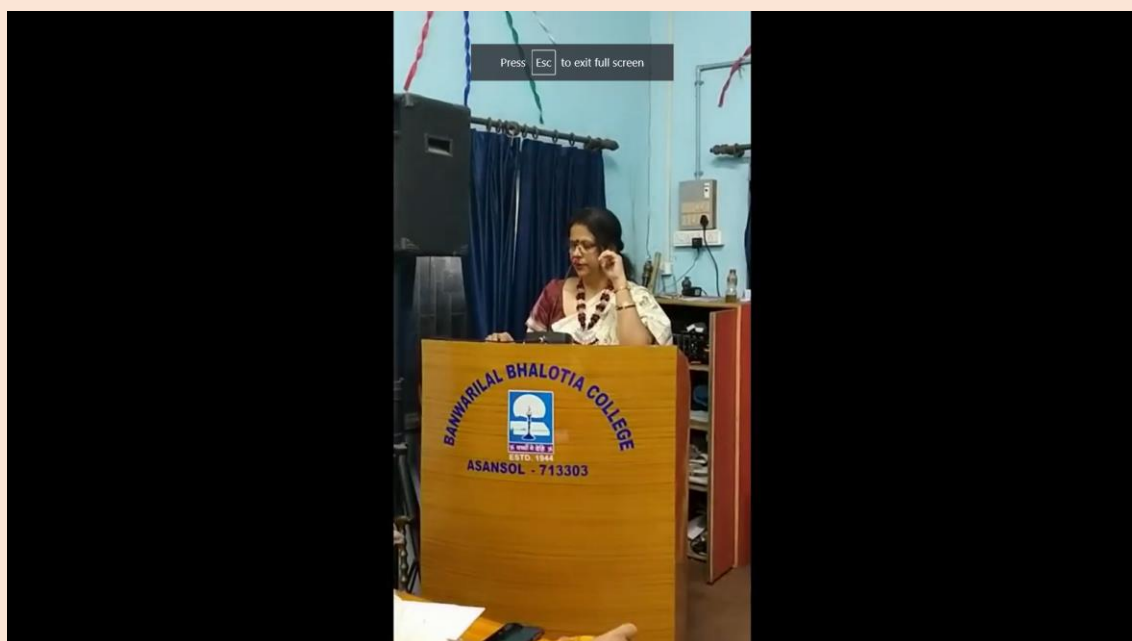
Future Perspectives:

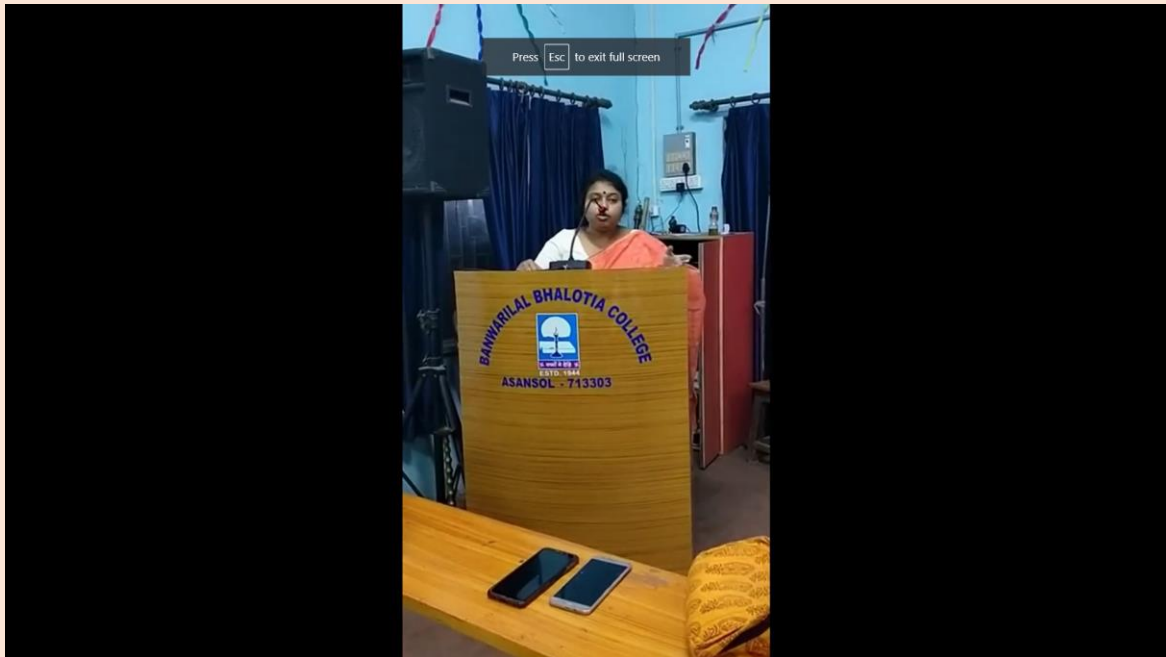

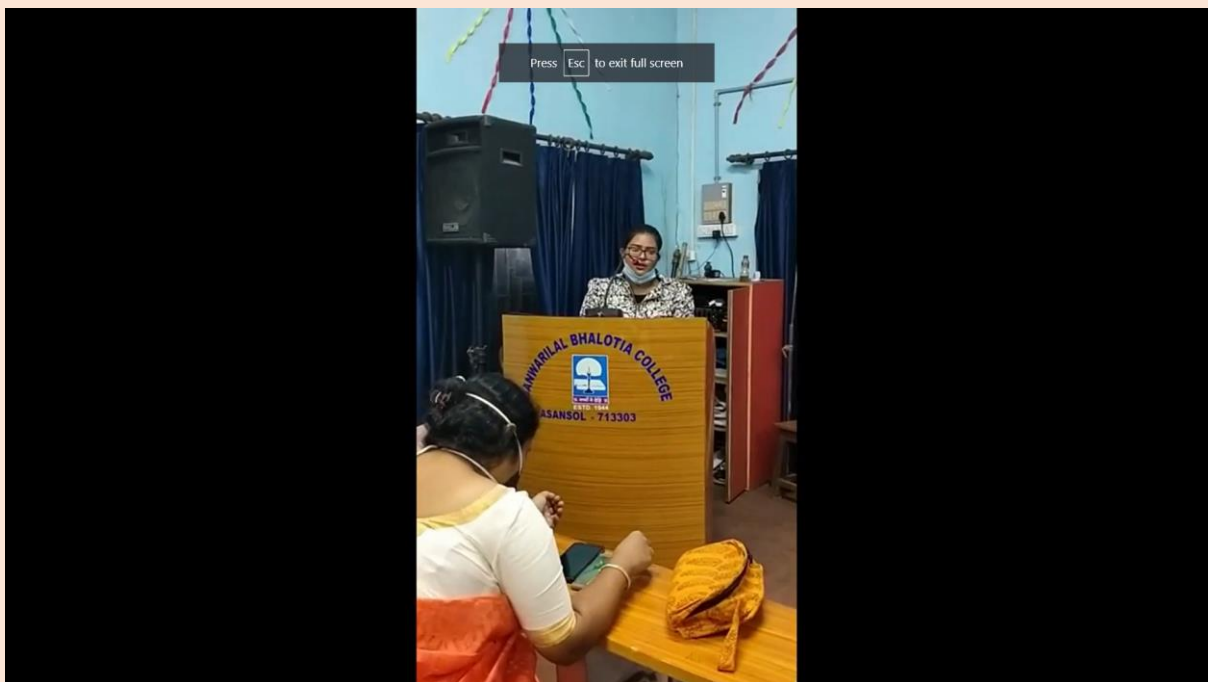
