Dept, BU, WB) on the topic "The Philosophy of the Indian Constitution", and Dr. Debasish Nandi (Pol. Sc. Dept, KNU, WB) delivering a talk on "The Reflection of Constitutional Spirit in India's Foreign Policy".

In this context, the NSS unit of the college organised several activities, thereby reminding us of our duties and commitment towards society. These activities also remind us that all of us have a defined role towards the alleviation of social inequality and poverty, and we can't win unless everybody wins. The various programmes that were taken up by the NSS unit include:
