Courses and Curriculum

- The College as affiliated doesn't have the freedom of developing its own curriculum. The Kazi Nazrul University develops the curriculum for undergraduate and post graduate courses.
- However, the faculties who are members of the Boards of Studies of the University participates in designing course curriculum of different subjects needed for effective delivery of the course content.
- On the basis of seniority, the faculty members are considered for the University Bodies like Boards of Studies. In such bodies the faculty members can represent the stakeholders like students, alumni, etc. and make necessary contributions.
- B.B. College offers undergraduate courses in various subjects of Arts, Commerce and Science streams (both general and honours). The college has also introduced courses like BBA, BCA, departmental training courses for Dry Farming, Cultivation, Vermi-Composting, Sericulture Training and Soil Water Analysis. Three distance education study centres of IGNOU, NSOU and MAANU also run on the campus.

Institutional Infrastructure for Teaching -Learning and Evaluation

Buildings and shifts: B.B. College was under "Centre for potential in excellence" scheme from 2013-2014. The classes are conducted in 4 major buildings and there are 2 administrative blocks. The college has 24 departments of various Arts, Science and Commerce Streams. The College runs into 3 shifts including Morning, Day, Evening and Hindi Shifts.

Classrooms: There are 66 class rooms, including 5 smart class rooms and 15 ICT enabled classrooms. There are 21 well equipped laboratories. There is a central laboratory facility for research purpose. The Main Building/Science Building has 72 rooms out of which 41 are classrooms and one seminar hall. The Humanities Building consists of total 29 rooms with 14 classrooms. The college library is housed here. The BBA/BCA building has 12 rooms, including 6 classrooms, 1 computer lab. Hindi shift building is adjacent to the main campus with 5 classrooms and one seminar hall. The College has one seminar hall-cum-ICT (120 seats) class room for conducting seminar, workshops and popular lectures.

The college have equipped science laboratories in Physics, Zoology, Microbiology, Botany and Chemistry Departments, and also ICT-enabled, wifi equipped Language and Computer laboratories to promote better teaching-learning.

Computers and Internet connection:

Total number of computers on campus for academic purposes is 144.

The centralized computer laboratory has about 70 computers which serve as a centralized facility for online examinations as well as for hands on practice of students. In addition, various departments have computers used for teaching and learning process. The Wi-Fi facilities have been added since 2014 covering the entire campus. The broadband service of the college was upgraded from 20 mbps to 50 mbps in 2018.

Central Library Facility: The library has a good collection of books including some rare books, journals etc. It is partially automated with SOUL 2.0 as ILMS since 2011 and

added with INFLIBNET, NDL, Nlist allowing access to e-resources. The institution spends sizeable amount of its budget on books for undergraduate and post graduate students.

Observations by Academic Audit Committee

Strengths
