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PREAMBLE

JIS UNIVERSITY was established in the year 2015 (According to West Bengal Legislative Assembly Act XXII of 2014) having its establishment at 81 Nilgunj Road, Agarpara, Kolkata - 700109 is engaged in the promotion of higher education and research in the country, herein referred to as 'JISU'.

PURPOSE

The purpose of the MOU is to enable cooperation between Department of Physics, JIS University at Agarpara and Department of Physics, B.B. College in pursuit of common mutual interests in teaching, laboratory facilities, cooperative and collaborative activities which will aim to foster advancement in science-based research, teaching, skill and cultural understanding.

The MOU between Department of Physics, JIS University & Department of Physics, B.B. College approves and facilitates the Faculty Members to enable them as research supervisors/ co-supervisors for Ph.D. Candidates from the collaborative Institute (both the parties).

ARTICLE 1: Forms of Cooperation

The parties envisage the following cooperation within the scope of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU).

ARTICLE 1.1: Exchange of Students

Organization of study visits and training, participation in guidance and supervision of student's project works may be conducted from both sides.

For the supervision of Ph. D Students:

For supporting professional help to PhD scholars of Department of Physics, JIS University, faculty members of the Department of Physics, B.B. College can act as Supervisor and/ or Co-Supervisor for PhD Scholars from either Institute. This will be based upon mutual consent of faculty of both the parties and approvals from the competent authorities of both the Institutes.

For Student Project:

A Faculty Member of Department of Physics, B.B. College can be a Guide of the Project work of the students of the Department of Physics, JIS University as cosupervisor with prior approval of the concerned authority. Similarly, a Faculty from JIS University can be a co-guide of the student's project of Department of Physics, B.B. College based on research requirement and approvals from the competent authorities.

ARTICLE 1.2: Sharing of research on mutually agreeable basis:

Exchange of information and cooperation in R&D in areas of interest like Atmospheric Physics, Material Science, Microwave shielding Materials, Nanotechnology and related interdisciplinary areas, including exchange of publication and reports may be shared by both the Institute on mutually agreeable basis.

ARTICLE 1.3: Twin Programs

Explore possibilities of joint twinning programs in interdisciplinary areas of specialization of high relevance to both parties.

ARTICLE 1.4: Others:

To jointly organize short-term continuing education programs, to organize seminars, conferences, or workshops on topics of mutual interest and invite faculty members from both the institutions to participate therein.

ARTICLE 2: Co-ordination

Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching/research faculty to coordinate the programme on its behalf and will periodically review to identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.

ARTICLE 3: Financial Obligations

There will be no financial obligations on both the parties under this agreement.

ARTICLE 4: Tenure

This MOU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for three years, and may be continued thereafter after suitable review and agreement.

ARTICLE 5: Arbitration Clause

Should there be a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation. Vice Chancellor of JIS University (JISU) and Principal of Banwarilal Bhalotia College (B.B. College) will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect, and shared responsibility.





1. Purpose & Scope

BANWARILAL BHALOTIA COLLEGE

The purpose of this Memorandum of Agreement is to set forth the terms and conditions, scope of work and responsibilities of the parties associated with their collaboration on various inter-disciplinary research and education related to estuarine and coastal studies. The 'MoU' will remain effective for 5 (Five) years from the date of signing. Research and educational programs would be conducted as and when required, either at the Banwarilal Bhalotia College, Asansol or at the Estuarine and Coastal Studies Foundation, Howrah or both the places combined on the basis of mutual consent. The 'MoU' may be extended or revised after every 5 (Five) years on mutual discussion between the two Institutes viz. Banwarilal Bhalotia College, Asansol and Estuarine and Coastal Studies Foundation. Introduction of research and educational initiatives and progress thereupon would be reported to Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the Banwarilal Bhalotia College, Asansol and the Director, Estuarine and Coastal Studies Foundation on a regular basis.





2. Financial arrangements:

No financial commitment is required / involved to execute the terms and conditions of the MoU. In case of any joint exercise if financial assistance received as extramural grant / scholarship / fellowship to students / researchers / faculty members of the Banwarilal Bhalotia College, Asansol and Estuarine and Coastal Studies Foundation, then that will be duly audited and acknowledged.

3. Terms and conditions:

It is mutually understood and agreed by and between the Banwarilal Bhalotia College, Asansol and the Estuarine and Coastal Studies Foundation that:

1. Scientists / Faculty members and students (UG and PG) of the Banwarilal Bhalotia College, Asansol and the Estuarine and Coastal Studies Foundation may collaborate in various inter-disciplinary research activities and may seek research funding from government and private funding agencies of national and / or international reputes.

2. Scientists / Faculty members of the Banwarilal Bhalotia College, Asansol and the Estuarine and Coastal Studies Foundation may mutually use and share research and education facilities on the basis of mutually agreed costs and / or bench fees and may jointly supervise projects / dissertations / thesis work of UG and PG students.

Scientists / Faculty members of the Banwarilal Bhalotia College, Asansol and the Estuarine and Coastal Studies Foundation may mutually conduct professional course / training / workshop / seminar / webinar / conference / field study for which certificates will be jointly issued by the Banwarilal Bhalotia College, Asansol and the Estuarine and Coastal Studies Foundation to all the candidates

after successful completion of the same.
4. Intellectual Property Rights framework for data sharing will be monitored , jointly by the Banwarilal Bhalotia College, Asansol and the Estuarine and Coastal Studies Foundation in connection to the output of the research work.



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5. In case of any dispute resulting from or related to this MoU, the Parties agree 5. In the resolve such dispute amicably, and shall escalate within their to attempt to resolve any such dispute and shall escalate within their to any organizations, any such dispute. This MoU shall be governed and construed according to the laws of the country for each participating party. Any dispute would be jointly resolved by involving the Principal of the Banwarilal Bhalotia College, Asansol and the Director of Estuarine and Coastal Studies Foundation in a spirit of independence, mutual respect, and shared responsibility. 6. The MoU may be terminated by either party after giving a notice of six months (180 days) provided that this clause will be operative only if either party violates the terms of MoU or if the parties feel that no useful purpose would be served by further continuing it either due to change in circumstances or change in constituting parties.

Entrepreneurship Development Cell – Swabalamban, Banwarilal Bhalotia College, Asansol

Dr. Abhik Kumar Mukherjee, Assistant Professor, Department of Business Administration, The University of Burdwan, Dr. Gautam Mazumdar, National Resource Person, National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM), Government of India, Mr. Uttam Laha, Industrial Development Officer, District Industries Center, Paschim Bardhaman, Mr. Soumen Chatterjee, President, Asansol Merchants Chamber of Commerce & Industry, Mr. Sambhu Nath Jha, Honorary Secretary, Asansol Chamber of Commerce were present as chief guests in the inauguration ceremony. Both Asansol Merchants Chamber of Commerce & Industry and Asansol Chamber of Commerce had assured us of all possible assistance to make this endeavor a success. The Department of Commerce (Hindi Shift) is mainly looking after its operation. All the faculty members are working by putting every effort towards achieving its goal. 

This MOU will respect Intellectual Property Rights and any intellectual matter developed by the collaborative efforts of two institutions shall be retained by them.

Article 7

DURATION AND TERMINATION

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- 2) The MOU shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years and may be extended for another period of five (5) years by the mutual written consent of the Parties.
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- 2) Such amendment/s or revision/s shall come into force on the date as may be determined by the Parties.

Article 9 SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES


