Theme of the Seminar

In the year of 2002, UNESCO held a Forum comprised of some of the many people who wanted to develop together a universal educational resource available for the whole of humanity. They chose the term "Open Educational Resource" to describe their efforts: Open Educational Resources are defined as "technology-enabled, open provision of educational resources for consultation, use and adaptation by a community of users for noncommercial purposes." They are typically made freely available over the Web or the Internet. Their principal use is by teachers and educational institutions support course development, but they can also be used directly by students. Open Educational Resources include learning objects such as lecture material, references and readings, simulations, experiments and demonstrations, as well as syllabi, curricula and teachers' guides. In today's educational domain it is urgent to know for every teachers and other stakeholders the process of creation and use of open educational resources. Ministry of Education and Commonwealth of learning developed policy on the promoting and using of open educational resources due to high costs of text books. In the Pandemic period when the doors of library have been closed, the subject wise availability of OER helped students and teachers a lot. In the case of promotion, teachers of the universities and colleges need to learn to create open educational resources. So the theme of the seminar is the technique for creating Open Educational Resources and the topic is effective and contemporary use of open educational resources.

Theme:

Creation and Use of Open Educational Resources
